New Talent: Six Rising Painters Exploring Landscape & Abstraction

Kirby Fredendall

Biography

Kirby Fredendall was raised in Carversville, Pennsylvania, in Bucks County, where art was part of everyday life rather than separated from it. As a young person, she was surrounded by working artists and their environments: sculptures integrated into an artist's backyard, a family friend who was a portrait painter capturing moments of her early life, and time spent in homes where painting and music shared the same rooms. These early experiences shaped her understanding of art as something physical and present, made by people she knew. She earned her BA from Duke University, where she studied art history. She earned her MEd from Arcadia University and teaches at a small private high school in Solebury, PA.

Fredendall's work is grounded in sustained observation of a single lake that she returns to over time. She uses the horizon as both a structural anchor and a point of tension, allowing it to balance against the shifting textures and colors of sky and water. In her paintings, the horizon, the surface of the water, and even what lies beneath the surface operate as competing visual destinations. Rather than describing what she sees, she works from what she feels in those moments, using subtle changes in color, surface, and proportion to build paintings that resist fixed readings. The work remains open, allowing mood and meaning to shift with each viewing and with the viewer's experience.

A dual attention to structure and material shapes her approach. An early exposure to the precision and order of Georgian architecture informed her sensitivity to balance, proportion, and restraint. Time spent working in a metalworking studio introduced her to tin as a surface shaped by process and chance. She works on acid-washed tin and canvas, allowing each surface to assert itself: on tin, the unpredictability of the acid-etched ground interacts with smooth, controlled glazes, while canvas permits more direct and expressive mark-making. Across both, her paintings maintain a controlled economy while remaining materially specific.

She is represented by Sarah Gormley Gallery, Candita Clayton Gallery, Susanna Gold Art Consultancy, and LAA Art Collective. Fredendall has maintained an active exhibition history for more than two decades, with work presented nationally in galleries and museums, including the James A. Michener Art Museum and the Woodmere Art Museum. Her work has been featured in publications including *Luxury Magazine*, *River Towns*, and *New American Paintings*, and is held in private collections throughout the United States.

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Artist Statement

Kirby Fredendall is a contemporary landscape painter who creates original oil paintings on acid-washed tin and canvas that explore memory, light, and the emotional experience of place.

The images are derived from elements she observes, then pulls apart and selectively reconfigures.

The viewer is gently led away from a directly observed image to one where a balance is struck between the known and the felt. The surface is organized into separate areas where one can experience the landscape as a vista across a body of water, as the transparency of light and objects seen beneath the water, and the combinations of light and color that play together among all of these views. The viewer can be drawn deep into the visual space or skate along the surface.

These shifting points of view enable her to selectively extract elements from the visual experience that most effectively convey a heightened awareness of the felt experience of the place. The artist's goal is to capture the sublime, remembered landscape.

She does not try to capture a specific place but rather a mood. She transports the viewer to a place remembered by the use of subtle color combinations that are found in the landscape. The use of the acid-washed tin allows her to create a surface that feels "of" water over which she describes a water place. Place is not simply location. These serene landscapes allow a moment of beauty for the viewer - a communication with a landscape past seen or experienced. A connection to the watery earth that seems to be more and more elusive.

As poet John O'Donohue writes: "With complete attention, landscape celebrates the liturgy of the seasons, giving itself unreservedly to the passion of the goddess. The shape of a landscape is an ancient and silent form of consciousness."

These contemporary landscape paintings are developed in the studio through observation, abstraction, and material experimentation.
